### INSOURCING JOBS IN AMERICA

#### Insourcing State Job Facts

- ▶ U.S. subsidiaries in South Carolina play a vital role in supporting jobs. They now employ 114,300 South Carolinians.
- ▶ South Carolina is an attractive location for international employers, ranking 16th in the United States in the number of employees supported by U.S. subsidiaries.
- ▶ In fact, the relative portion of jobs in South Carolina supplied by U.S. subsidiaries remains significant. They provide the livelihood for over 7% of South Carolina's private-sector workforce.
- ▶ South Carolina is tied with Connecticut as 1st in the country in the share of its workforce supported by U.S. subsidiaries.

#### INSOURCING MANUFACTURING JOB FACTS

- ▶ U.S. subsidiaries support 55,800 manufacturing jobs in South Carolina. Manufacturing companies tend to have a strong "multiplier" effect on the economy—stimulating a substantial amount of activity and jobs in other sectors through their demand for inputs from other suppliers.
- ▶ Almost 22% of manufacturing jobs in South Carolina are supported by U.S. subsidiaries.
- ▶ U.S. subsidiaries' employment in South Carolina is heavily concentrated in manufacturing. Nearly 50% of these jobs are in manufacturing industries.

#### Insourcing National Job Facts

- ▶ U.S. subsidiaries consistently support millions of American jobs. They now employ 5.3 million Americans—or 4.5% of private sector employment.
- ▶ U.S. subsidiaries support an annual payroll of \$364.2 billion.
- ▶ U.S. subsidiaries provide an average compensation per U.S. worker of \$68,317; this is 32% percent higher than compensation at all U.S. companies.
- ▶ U.S. subsidiaries also spent \$160 billion on plant construction and new equipment.
- ▶ U.S. subsidiaries' share of U.S. manufacturing employment represents 11 percent of American manufacturing jobs.

## One Company's Story

In January 2007, **FOOD LION**, a U.S. subsidiary of the Belgium-based Delhaize Group which operates in more than 1,200 supermarkets, began development and construction of four new stores in Anderson, Woodruff, Greer, and Union, SC. Each store will include a 35,000-square foot Food Lion store and 8,400-square feet of retail shops. Completion of the shopping centers and the opening of the Food Lions are expected by the fall of 2007, with over 350 jobs being created at each site.
